## an active attacker or threat

An **active attacker** is **defined** as an individual actively engaged in killing or attempting to kill people in a confined and populated area. Attacks are unpredictable in any environment. Individual mental and physical preparation is necessary before law enforcement can arrive.







## If a safe path is available,

- **RUN** Do not hesitate
- Leave your belongings
- Discourage others from entering the area
- Escape or evacuate to a safe location
- **Do not stop** to assist wounded
- Call police when it is safe to do so

## If you can't get out safely,

- HIDE Stay out of the attacker(s)' view
- Be quiet
- Silence your phone
- Lock/barricade doors
- Call police when it is safe to do so

## As a last resort,

- DEFEND With absolute commitment
- Be physical and aggressive
- Be loud and vocal
- Consider using objects as improvised weapons
- Fight to **incapacitate** the attacker(s)
- Call police when it is safe to do so
